Friendly Reminder

With "Garage Sale" season upon us please be courteous and mindful of where you place your advertising signs. It is against deed restrictions to place any sign in the flower beds at the entrances of the subdivision or at corners of streets or in residents' yards. This is unsightly and left to the homeowner to clean up. It is illegal to put the signs on stop signs and light poles. All signs must be removed as soon as the sale is over. Thank you for helping keep our neighborhood clean.



Pool Dates and Rules

The pool will be opening on Memorial Day weekend. Parents: please go over the rules of the pool with your children, so we can keep them safe. We want them to have fun without getting hurt or hurting others. The rules listed here and the pool.

Pool Rules:

1. Lifeguard has ultimate authority and can remove anyone who is not following the pool rules.
2. No running or rough play.
3. No glass or alcoholic beverages.
4. No diving in shallow end – 5ft or less.
5. No swimming in diving area.
6. Only one person on diving board.
7. Dive only from the end of the diving board.
8. There is a designated 10 minute period every hour only adults are allowed in the pool.
9. No loud music in pool area.
10. No pets inside pool area.
11. No cut – offs or t-shirts allowed in pool.
12. No children under 11 years of age will be permitted without

supervision of an adult at least 18 years of age.

13. Pool Tags must be presented upon entry, and members must sign in and out each time they use the pool.
14. Guest must be accompanied by member, by member, registered and guest fee paid. Members are responsible for their guest following the rules.
15. No one is permitted inside the pool or during closed hours unless a special arrangement has been made for rental of the area with pool Chairperson or the Board of Directors.
16. Anyone using suntan lotions or oils must shower before swimming.
17. Lifeguards are not responsible for supervision of baby pool. Adults must be present at the edge. Use of the baby pool is restricted to children 6 years of age and younger.
18. Repeated removal from pool area for misconduct will result in loss of pool privileges for such time as designated by the Board of Directors.

Q: What is the recommended lawn fertilizer treatment for this season? **A:** If you have not already fertilized your yard there is still time. Most lawn specialist suggests an application of 15-3-10 weed and feed. This needs to be applied before hot weather. You may also want to use an insecticide to ward off lawn pests. **Q:** Why do the street lamps on Fallbrook only partially cover HBTM? **A:** These street lamps were provided by Reid Road Mud #2. At this time Reid Road Mud #1 does not have plans to install street lamps.
